Course of the seminar:	The seminars range from group discussions, analysis of current case law to individual consultations.
Frequency of seminar meetings:	Once a week.

Obligations of a student participating in the seminar:	Seminarians are obliged to actively participate in discussions, and once a semester to present the progress in the preparation of the master's thesis on the forum.
Conditions for passing the seminar:	Regular participation and involvement in the work of the seminar group, as well as the presentation of the progress of one's own scientific development.
